

Sign Permit

Sign Permits are required unless you're installing a sign inside a building, directional signs, or where you're not changing the sign face area or height of existing signs.

If you are unsure, contact Planning Services to be certain.

Submit a Sign Permit Application including the required drawings, site plans, and any other necessary information

The Development Officer will review the submission to ensure compliance with the Sign Bylaw and any other pertinent bylaws or regulations.

If a Sign Permit is not approved or if you disagree with the conditions, you may appeal to the Development Appeals Board.

Note: The Sign Permit may be approved with conditions, if so, it is your responsibility to adhere to the noted conditions.
